CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

Students must abide by the *Code of Conduct for Students*, henceforth referred to as the **Code** and must follow all rules and regulations mentioned herewith:

1. All the students must conduct themselves in a befitting manner that upholds the dignity of an Academic Institution. Such conduct is based on mutual respect for individuals and respecting the Rights of every stakeholder of the Institution.
2. There must be academic honesty and integrity.
3. Students must remember that they are accountable for their deeds and answerable to the college authority.
4. If the behaviour of the student adversely affects the principles of equity, justice and morality, measure may be taken against the concerned student(s).
5. It is the vision and mission of the college to maintain an atmosphere of harmony and inclusiveness for students of diverse backgrounds. In this regard students must not make any abusive or hurtful remark on grounds of culture, religion, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, caste, race, disability etc.
6. At the time of admission, students are required to sign a declaration that they shall not indulge in any kind of Ragging in the college campus and any act of misconduct shall be dealt with seriously and action will be taken against the unruly students.
7. Students must check the college website regularly for important notices and instructions.
8. Students are required to follow all deadlines and submit academic work on time. They have to abide by the schedule set by the college/department for submission of Internal/Tutorial/Project work/ Viva etc.
9. Arrogance or unbecoming language or misconduct in any form is sufficient reason for the expulsion of a student.
10. Students must attend classes regularly. As per the norms laid down by the University of Calcutta, 75% attendance is compulsory.
11. Students must appear for all unit or class tests or Internal examinations conducted by respective Departments. The overall academic performance of the students is taken note of.
12. Damage or destruction of college property is a punishable offence.
13. Library Books should be returned on time.
14. Students must return books before the end of each semester exam.
15. Students must carry their Identity card to enter into the college campus.
16. Students should not litter the college campus with food and plastic.
17. Students must use litter bins to drop used and unwanted materials.
