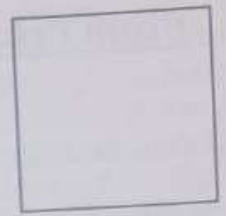

## From Principal's / Teacher-in-Charge's Desk

### :: Message ::

My Dear Students –
